My first experience of Covid-19 in a child under2 years ...

18 month old boy, with no notable history, background

Transmission of SARS-Cov2 possible in the nursery (5 cases among the staff and as much in children, the place ahs been closed structure (well I would think ... !!!) for sanitary measures) presenting high severity for 24 hours:

fever at 39 ° C, (marked) deterioration in general condition, loss appetite, diarrhea, grimaces or even moans when moved/manipulated (myalgia?), dyspnea without cyanosis, moderate labored breathing, cough, disseminated wheezing, diffuse rattling affecting both lungs with some diffuse sub-crackles also (no crackles localised), atypical skin rashes (mixed between aspect of stellate angioma and livedo but of very pale color - pink-), aspect of acute otitis media left-side on otoscopy, no cervical lymphadenopathy ... Starting treatment with ANTIBIOTIC * (OMA coverage for less than 24 months) and

ANTIHISTAMINE * with total disappearance of symptoms after... the 1st intake.

On D5: only symptom = liquid stool related to the effect of ANTIBIOTIC*

It's always that but ... for all those who will not receive antihistamine, how will your symptoms progress?
